*Documents to consider running a Bible school, using the CLT curriculum*

## Documents drawn up for the running of a Bible School

New Centre is a folder for those considering the CLT curriculum and method, to be offered as a local Church Bible School. It provides an opportunity to train members to be better workers, leaders and ministers of the gospel. It is an accredited course leading to recognised credits which can be RPL'ed into an accredited qualification. Students can after three years achieve a Diploma which gives access to several Bachelor programmes at higher institutions (CU).

### New Tuition Centre

This main document of the **New Centre** folder lists all the different information packs. It contains a short introduction, highlighting the most important aspects such as the costs, benefits, recognition and the completion of the **Applicant Data** form — to register the Bible School.

### Bible School Packs Intro

This PowerPoint slideshow introduces the seven Packs which are found in Dean Docs. Each Pack is the central document to about 3 to 6 other documents which each cover an important aspect of starting and running a Tuition Centre.

### Phase 1-3 Codes, Subjects, Schedules

This pdf document lists all the module names of the first three Phases. Phase 1 is on one page and an explanation of the contents of the main lecture books is provided on a following page. Then follows two pages for Phase 2 and lastly two pages for Phase 3. Important lists!

### Calvary Academics Introduced

This PowerPoint slideshow introduces CA which is the curriculum — backed by Calvary University (an accredited institution — South Africa and elsewhere). Several aspects are highlighted. Useful to show to students or to convince the church board to adopt the programme.

### Christian Basics Sample Lecture

The teaching material is of a very high professional standard. To give the Church board (and future students) confidence that the CLT is the right material for training their members, a sample lecture will give insight into the construction of a typical lecture: An index to the other accompanying lectures (showing context). An introduction to the current series of lectures, an overview of the lecture details, including Session Topics, the Outcomes of the lecture and the specific Objectives of the lecture.

The four topics in the whole CHB1 volume are:

- The Godhead
- Foundation Doctrines
- Personal Development
- Christian Character

The combination of these four topics (formerly published in 7 A5 books) forms an excellent start to the ministry training which students will enjoy for 3 years.
