

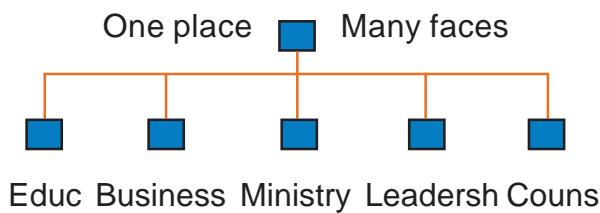

Calvary University offers a whole range of programmes for the professions as well as for the practical skills professions

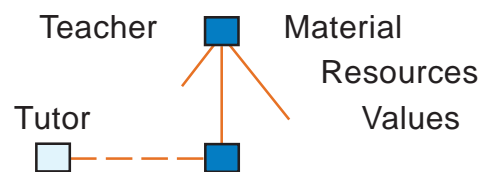


One Lord, one faith, one baptism.

Knowledge, skills and attitude is transferred to the student to duplicate the **teacher** – with the help of a **tutor**: the academic version of **disciple making**.

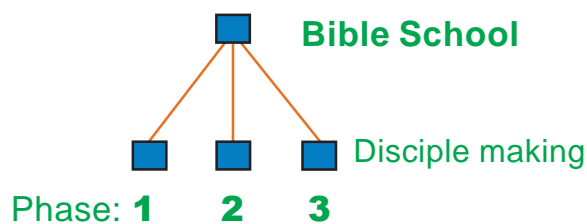

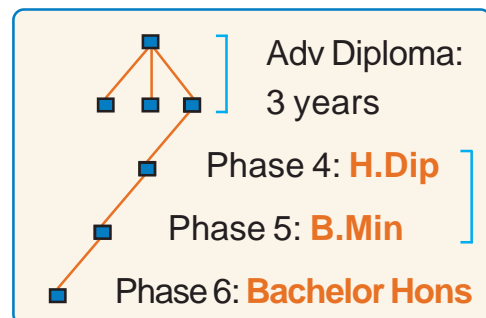


For three years Paul admonished them

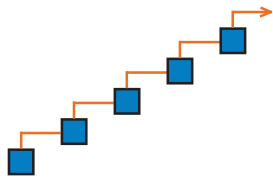
### Profession: Phase 4 etc.

## Registration Steps

A student must take the following steps:

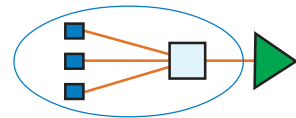
1. Select a Tuition Centre.
2. Decide on a programme.
3. Provide proof of previous qualification.
4. Bring a copy of your Identity Document
5. Complete the registration form and pay the required registration fee.

## Elements

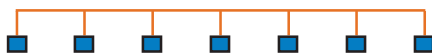
## e-Learning Elements

e-Learning consists of the following elements that each provide a source of information, learning or guidance:

1. Textbooks – covering all the work needed for one year part time study
2. UFD or "stick" gives the edge to e-learning by providing material
3. Relevant skills unique to Calvary
4. Tutor – a pillar of strength near you
5. Spiritual formation because God's Word is the basis for all we do.
6. Evaluation – provides the driving force behind academic effort.

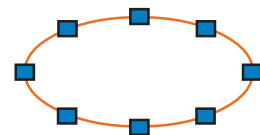
## 7 Modules per Phase

Each Phase consists of seven modules consisting of the following components:

1. Text Books (seven of them, one per module)
2. Workbooks (companion books in three mods.)
3. Practical Skills (comp. books in four mods.)
4. One IT skill (starting at Computer Basics)
5. Praxis Workbook (for completing practicals)
6. Group discussion Guide (groups of 5 to 8)
7. 2 Bible Chapter readers (28 Bible Chapters)

Eighteen books and a Study guide.

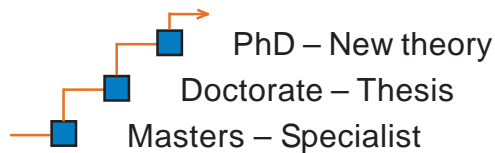
## Academic Work

Several components enhance learning:

1. Reading – pre-reading text book
2. Class session – taking notes
3. Memorising for test(s); anticipating
4. Group discussion – learning to speak
5. Doing research: finding and reading
6. Analysing – sorting, ordering, using
7. Assignment: report/essay writing
8. Compiling a workfile of all work done

Life long learning: 3 progs. Phase 7 to 9

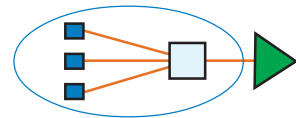
1. Be 40+ and have a Bachelors degree.
2. Otherwise have an honours degree.
3. Have specialist field in mind.
4. Attend 15 Postgraduate seminars
5. Write a deissertation/Thesis of 150-250p

### Throughout the year:

Meet the second Friday every month Feb to Nov. in Pretoria (10 times) or 5 times per year (double sessions) in Durban, Cape Town.

## Elements

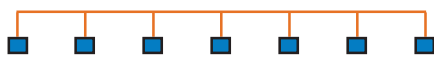
## The Rules

Calvary students accept the following:

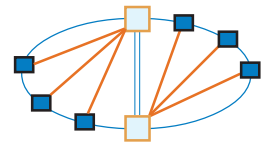
## Ministry — Practical work

Each Phase consists of seven modules consisting of the following components:

1. Reading Bible chapters (4 per module)
2. Memorising Scripture (7 or per module)
3. Church ministry (local church serving)
4. Community serving (Elderly, poor, sick)
5. Missionary Outreach (local or tour)
6. Evangelism or counselling (altar work)
7. Disciple Making (See the next point)

Eighteen books and a Study guide.

## Disciple Making

Several components enhance learning:

1. Two covenant to support each other
2. Duplication of knowledge, character
3. Starting three disciple families
4. Helping/training them to go 4 deep

### Learning basic skills:

- A:** Interpersonal communication
- B:** The making of a leader
- C:** Group dynamics

**Note:** The Advanced diploma is issued only upon proof of having 3 disciples.
