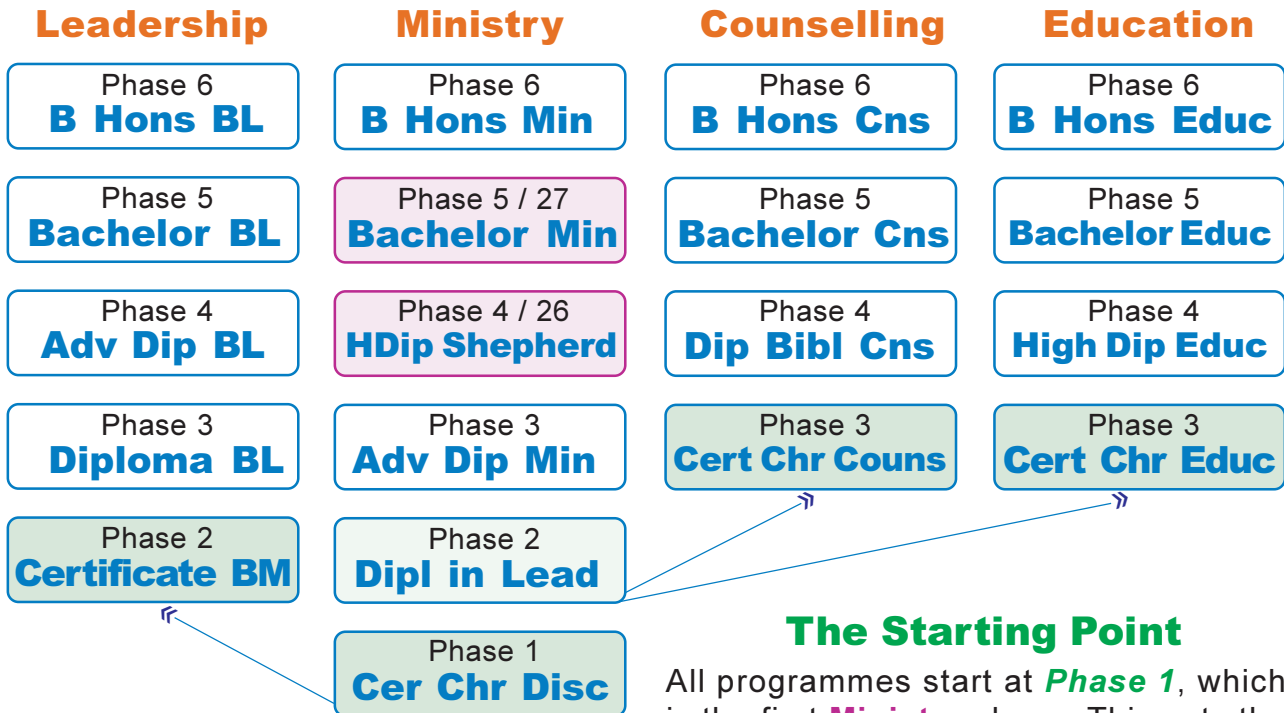

An Overview of CLT Programmes

CLT offers Phases of 80 credits each in four different streams: Ministry, Counselling, Education and Business Leadership. Here is a graphic presentation:



Modules and Phases

Every phase consists of seven Modules containing **text books** and practical **skills**. These are suitable for part-time students to gain credits which will lead to qualifications. Business students may start at **Phase 2** in their second study year. **Counselling** and **Education** students must first finish Phase 1 & 2 to start on **Phase 3**.

Diploma, Bachelor, Post-graduate

A Diploma takes three years. Students who need a minimum qualification may decide where to end their training and in which field (Advanced or Higher Diploma).

The Bachelor programmes. Following any three phases are two Phases (4 & 5) which provide **4 different Bachelors** in the mentioned fields. Phase 26 & 27 is for Ministry students and provides an excellent alternative to Phase 4 & 5.

Post-grad: Phase 7, the Masters, follows Phase 6 (Honours) and is the preparation for the Doctoral programme. The candidate now learns to **do research** in order to acquire specialist knowledge. In the doctoral Phase 8, candidates make a **contribution** to one of the fields mentioned. The PhD phase is reserved for a second Doctoral to formulate a **new theory**. ■
